#### **Public Comments:**

Chris Hlavka summarized the City Council discussions of 12/08 regarding proposed closure of Higgins Ave and routing of Stevens Creek Trail.

## **Discussion:**

- 1. Minutes of November 16 approved (7-0)
- 2. Loyola Corners Streetscape concept plan. Dave Brees, special projects manager, gave a presentation about proposed improvements to the Loyola Corners business district. Changes involve switching 'A'Street to one-way north, with free turns onto Miramonte. Miramonte would get sidewalks, bike lanes, and planted medians. Crosswalks and sidewalks would be improved. BPAC members commented that provisions need to be made for bicycle thrupassage on Fremont, both north-west-bound and south-east-bound.
- 3. Green Town Los Altos Vision for Downtown Los Altos. Forrest Linebarger presented a proposal that would convert downtown to a higher density, mixed use area with better provisions for pedestrians, bicyclists, shoppers, and residents. A major component is converting parking plazas to underground garages with mixed use buildings above.
- 4. Agenda items for next meeting: Bicycle Transportation Plan, Loyola Corners Concept Plan comments to City Council, 2010 goals, Capital Improvement Projects, recap of Lunch with City Manager, proposed addition of <a href="www.kikely.com">www.kikely.com</a> to website. Election of chairperson and secretary.
