May 16, 2007 Meeting Minutes**

Discussion Items

- 1) Minutes of April 18, 2007 and previous meetings passed (4-0).
- 2) Replacement candidates for vacant BPAC seat: Bill Crook has talked to two candidates who had applied for other City commission positions.
- 3) Stevens Creek Task Force: Ad posted in Town Crier (\$400) for May 30 community meeting at Grant Park Multipurpose Room. BPAC members encouraged to post fliers around community.
- 4) Bike Detector spreadsheet. All input is in; Scott will assemble and send to Staff. There are quite a few intersections which do not detect bikes.
- 5) Bike to Work Day is tomorrow.
- 6) Bike racks. 70 ordered, 8-week delivery time. Sites plotted. Chris Hlavka to review plot/photo surveys and comment. One public comment received.
- 7) VTA BPAC: Mary Ave ped/bike bridge estimate was \$6M; low bid is \$12M.
- 8) Adobe Creek Bridge: San Francisco Water District needs to approve the package before Caltrans can advertise it for bidding.
- 9) Member of public commented about bicyclists crossing Covington at Golden Way in an unsafe manner.
