

**Los Altos Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee Meeting  
April 18, 2007**

- 1) Minutes of March 2007 meeting approved (5-0)
- 2) Stevens Creek Trail Update. Minutes of SCT task force posted on website. Staff met separately w/Alta Design (project consultant) and used written input from FOSCT and SCTF suggestions for conducting public meetings. Want to have public meeting May 30. How to publicize? Article in Town Crier/PA Daily/SJ Mercury? Paid ad in TC? Cost of mailing to all Los Altos households was \$8-9000 for recent sewer notice. Larry says there is no money in budget for public notification. Randy will work with SCTF to work on Town Crier.
- 3) Bike detection at signalized intersections. Carl, Bill, and Chris all tried to collect data but it was incomplete, esp. regarding whether signals actually detect bikes. Scott will send spreadsheet for them to use when re-evaluating those intersections.
- 4) Bike to Work Day is May 17. Randy will borrow tables from Hillview Rec Ctr and deliver to site on Foothill. Henry to ask Bicycle Outfitter and Chain Reaction for giveaway. Carl to ask Safeway for donations. How about Peet's Coffee?
- 5) Design Review list for 2007-8. Larry says the project list is too likely to change and not reliable. Suggest revisiting during June after Council makes more progress.
- 6) Bike racks: 70 racks; going to Council for expense authorization as consent item
- 7) VTA update: Nothing important for BPAC specifically.
- 8) Traffic Commission: Casita Way traffic calming approved and sent to Council. Accident data analysis process. Recommendation to survey 3 sites (Carmel Terrace, Oak Ave, W. Portola) for potential Safe Routes to School projects; need funding from Council.
- 9) Adobe Creek Bridge: Caltrans funds available in May 07. May require large scope for Environmental Impact Report.
