CALL TO ORDER

Roll Call: Curt Riffle (Chairperson), Scott Chan, Ed Coble, Bill Crook, Carl Hagenmaier, and

Henry Pastorelli were present. Ed Coble was absent.

Public Comments:

No public comments were offered.

Discussion:

- 1. Minutes of July 20, 2005 BPAC meeting were approved.
- 2. ADA updates (Ed/All)

Rancho funding was not included in approved CDBG process. Larry thinks there will be surplus from the downtown work. BPAC should push staff to suggest to Council to use the surplus at Rancho. Bill moved that BPAC as the Traffic Commission recommend to Council that any surplus CDBG funds from the downtown ADA work be dedicated to Rancho ADA work. Seconded and approved.

3. VTA BPAC Update (Scott)

Scott reported on two discussion topics:

- i. was pedestrian access to expressways.
- ii. was proposal to for specifying VTA BPAC review (at 35% completion) of county roadway. Larry says Michelle says we could use the \$80K for the Stevens Creek study on the Adobe Creek bridge design.

We need to reapply for Stevens Creek for next year's VTA funding. At next meeting Larry will tell us:

- i. The process that results in starting the Stevens Creek study next year (VTA deadline appears to be deadline is 12/1/2005. Per city plan, project is budgeted for FY starting July 1, 2006)
- ii. The process that results in for getting Adobe Creek started this year.

AI: Stevens Creeks should be a standing agenda item.
