We appealed a 2 story monster home development in our neighborhood and I was shocked to find out it would cost \$1500 for the appeal, but if the protesting party had been within the "written notice" area (described to me by a planning department member as the houses most closely sited to the disputed site, and this usually included 2 houses on all sides of the protested project, the fee was only \$500. This seems completely unfair, since there is a Yellow Public Posting on the site announcing the proposed project to the ENTIRE neighborhood. When questioned on this at a Council meeting, Curtis Cole stated that the city offered a "discount" to neighbors who would be most directly impacted by the project. This seems like complete BALONEY and unequal treatment for other members of a neighborhood that want to protect the charm and character of their neighborhood. Subsequent to losing our appeal, we implemented a single story overlay on the project. The cost of the process was \$4075, plus we had to pay for stamps/envelopes for 2 mailings to homes within 500' of the boundaries of the neighborhood seeking the overlay. This seems like an excessively high fee, especially since now the City Council has categorically stated that it will not deny a 2 story monster home in a consistent character, single story neighborhood unless the single story overlay is in place. I feel that our citizen's right to protest such projects under the 2002 Los Altos General Plan, and to have reasonable expectation that the protest would be supported by Council , is a significant reduction in our ability to protect consistent character neighborhoods. Since we are forced into having a "single story overlay", the fees should be much lower, since it seems to me that the neighborhood must do most of the work.
