Of the Mayor

Of the City of Los Altos, California

WHEREAS, National Bike Month is held every May to recognize bicycling as a resource to improve citizens' health and well-being, grow our City's economy, improve traffic safety, support student learning outcomes, reduce pollution, congestion, and the wear and tear on our streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, the City of Los Altos and local school districts have promoted bicycling for over 3 decades via our Complete Streets Commission and Safe Routes to School Program (launched in 2020) to increase the number of students walking and bicycling to school and reduce the number of vehicle trips associated with school travel; and

WHEREAS, throughout the month of May, the residents of Los Altos and its visitors will experience the joys of bicycling through educational programs, commuting events, bike recycling, or by simply getting out and going for a ride to further our goal of encouraging residents of all ages and abilities to become lifelong cyclists;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jonathan D. Weinberg, Mayor of the City of Los Altos, California, do hereby proclaim May, 2024, to be
