7:00 P.M. – REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

Items for Consideration

1. Council Minutes: The City Council approved the minutes of the July 7, 2020 Special Meeting and July 14, 2020 Regular Meeting.
2. Los Altos Community Center Furniture Purchase: The City Council approved the purchase of new fixtures, furnishings and equipment at the new Community Center with One Workplace, Interior Motions and KBM-Hogue.
3. Budget Adjustment for Cuesta Drive Traffic Calming Project TS-01022: The City Council approved the allocation of necessary funds from Traffic Impact Fees to fully implement the project.
4. Effluent Transfer Agreement: The City Council authorized the City Manager to execute the Effluent Transfer Agreement with the City of Palo Alto.
5. Appeal of Design Review Commission Approval of a New Two-Story House at 126 Mount Hamilton Avenue – Appellant E. Hyman: The City Council held a public hearing to consider appeal of Design Review Commission's approval of application SC19-0010 for construction of a new, two-story house at 126 Mount Hamilton Avenue. The City Council referred Resolution No. 2020-32 upholding the Design Review Commission's approval to staff to work with the project architect to reduce the bulk and mass of the second story.
6. Appeal of Administrative Determination of Structure at 714 Arroyo Road – Appellants K. and R. Heley: The City Council held a public hearing to consider appeal of the administrative determination that a structure located near the rear property line at 714 Arroyo Road is an accessory structure and must comply with accessory structure site standards for properties in a residential zone district. The City Council affirmed the Community Development Director's determination that the structure is an accessory structure and must comply with accessory structure site standards and provided the appellant the opportunity to work with the Community Development Director to modify the structure to comply with City requirements.
7. Police Town Hall Follow Up: The City Council continued this item to September 8, 2020.
8. Changing the Zoning and/or General Plan Land Use Designation for Civic Center Lands: The City Council continued this item to September 8, 2020.
9. Emergency Measures for Addressing COVID-19: Receive an update from the City Manager and provide direction and discuss mandatory face covering regulations

The City Council continued this item.

10. Legislative Update: The City Council continued this item.
