2. <u>Downtown Zoning Amendments</u>

Consideration of amendments to the Municipal Code for the following three primary downtown zoning districts:

Commercial Retail Sales District

Eliminating the 100% Floor Area Ratio restriction.

Commercial Downtown District

Increasing the allowed building envelope from two stories in height to three stories and eliminating the 80% Floor Area Ratio restriction.

Commercial Service District

Eliminating the 50% Floor Area Ratio restriction.

An environmental Negative Declaration has been prepared for these proposed changes.
