#### Tree Protection Ordinance

DeMichiel opened discussion about recommended changes to the Tree Protection Ordinance. Zito added that the Planning Commission had asked staff to reconsider the recommended changes and propose an ordinance that would protect all tree varities. Zito is to forward the report from the Community Development Director and existing ordinance to the committee for further discussion.

Zito distributed a report documenting the preliminary research staff has done on the formation of a Green Building Ordinance. No action was taken.

## Green Building Policy Workshop

Information was also distributed about an upcoming Green Building workshop in San Jose.
