1. Approval of Minutes of the Meeting, February 28, 2022

2. <u>Presentation.</u> Mid-year Budget review

Gabriel Engeland, City Manager, explained the subcommittee's discussions with staff and their input in the mid-year budget process.

John Furtado, Finance Director, presented the Mid-year budget and proposed changes

The commissioners discussed the presentation and thanked the subcommittee for their work on the Midyear, the subcommittee briefed the commission that they were supportive of all the recommendations made with the caveat that the council be cautioned on the use of the operating and emergency reserve in the future. They also recommended that staff review reserve policies of other cities and report back in the future if a 20% Reserve was adequate or needed to be increased.

3. Memo. IT Systems and Cyber Security Report

Chair Kalkat, requested clarification if looking at Cybersecurity was under the purview of the Financial Commission as it was not on the Charter. The Commissioners discussed the issue

and the City Manager recommended that the Commission raise the subject with Council at the Joint meeting if this would be something that the City Council would like to add to the Charter to the Financial Commission.

The commissioners had no other comments on the Memo and Commissioner Claras reported that he had sent some comments directly to staff. Commissioner Richmond cautioned staff that the cost of cyber security insurance had increased very significantly and that should be kept in mind as the city developed the FY 23 Budget.
