WIDESPREAD

Many non-essential indoor business operations are closed

- Curbside/Walkup Services at all Community Libraries
- 24 Hours weekly in person services, per library
- Phone, Email and Chat Patron Support M-Sa 10A-6P
- Computer Appointments and Printing at four locations
- Virtual Programs

SUBSTANTIAL

Some non-essential indoor business operations are closed

- Lobby Service 25-50% occupancy at all Community Libraries
- 30 Hours weekly in person services, per library
- Phone, Email and Chat Patron Support M-Sa 10A-6P
- Expanded computer use and printing at all community libraries
- Virtual Programs

MODERATE

Some indoor business operations are open with moderations

- Full Building Access up to 50% occupancy at all Community Libraries
- 30 Hours weekly in person services, per library
- Phone, Email and Chat Patron Support M-Sa 10A-6P
- Expanded computer use and printing at all community libraries
- Virtual Programs

MINIMAL

Most indoor business operations are open with modifications

- Full Building Access up to 75% occupancy at all Libraries
- 30 Hours weekly in person services, per library; plus expanded hours by community
- Phone, Email and Chat Patron Support M-Sa 10A-6P
- Full computer use and printing at all libraries
- Meeting Room Access considered
