REPORTS

Cheryl Houts, Community Librarian

The Library is kicking off Summer Reading Club on Saturday, June 2nd with the Tech Challenge program and a long list of summer activities for kids, teens and adults! This year the children's librarians have decided to change things up a bit. They are allowing kids to choose their own reading goals and have provided parents with tips for encouraging their kids' participation in summer reading. Teen Librarian, Sarah Neeri is excited about the grand prize for teens completing summer reading – an iPod shuffle! Adults in our community are very fortunate to have the opportunity to hear John Lescroart on June 26th at 7pm. Adults are being encouraged to pick up a summer reading packet and participate too.

There is regular preschool programming continuing throughout the summer and four programs for adults too. A wireless update concludes that there are 450 users at Los Altos Library and 10 at Woodland.

Melinda Cervantes, County Librarian

Melinda spoke about the SB156 which is the California Reading and literacy Improvement and Public Library Construction and Renovation Bond Act of 2008. She also spoke about the Silicon Valley Reads Program for 2008 which will feature Bo Caldwell's book *Distant Land of My Father*. The JPA Board will adopt the FY 2007/08 Santa Clara County Library Budget at their next meeting on Thursday, June 7, 2007 at 2pm.

Gerry Dunckel, Friends of the Library

Gerry reported that the Friends of the Los Altos Library's book sale in May brought in a total of \$19,000. Also, the Amazon Book Sales are regularly around \$600.00 per month.
