

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-12A

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS MAKING CERTAIN MODIFICATIONS TO RESOLUTION 2010-12 APPROVING THE LOS ALTOS COMMUNITY CENTER MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, all required public notices and public hearings were duly given and duly held according to law; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2010, the City Council approved the Los Altos Community Center Master Plan ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2010, the City Council certified that as the decision-making body, it reviewed and considered the information contained in the Final EIR, which was comprised of the Draft EIR dated November 2009 and the Final EIR dated February 2010, and other information in the record, prior to acting upon or approving the Project, and found that the Final EIR had been completed in compliance with CEQA and reflected the independent judgment and analysis of the City of Los Altos as lead agency for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2010, the City Council directed staff to make certain changes to the resolution approving the Project; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2010, the City Council reconsidered Resolution 2010-12; and

WHEREAS, said reconsideration of Resolution 2010-12 is not intended to modify or alter the certification of the Final EIR or Project approval dated March 9, 2010, but is intended to clarify certain findings that the City Council directed staff to make; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution 2010-12A shall be considered with Resolution 2010-12 to reflect the final Project approval dated March 9, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY make the following modifications to Resolution 2010-12:

"WHEREAS, pursuant to the Master Plan, the City Council has identified both the existing apricot orchard trees shown to be retained, and the new *apricot* orchard trees shown to be planted adjacent to the History Museum, as being a requirement of the Master Plan."

There are no other modifications to the whereas clauses contained Resolution No. 2010-12.

4. Construct Orchard Alternative

"Under the Construct Orchard alternative, the project site would be redeveloped exactly as described under the proposed project, except an apricot orchard would be constructed on the site in the area that currently contains the baseball field, which is approximately 0.7 acres in size. Under the Project, this area would be planted with a smaller apricot orchard and the remainder would be converted to an open space area that could contain trees, grass turf, and picnic tables, or something similar."


There are no other modifications to the Construct Orchard Alternative contained in Resolution No. 2010-12.

“MM CUL-2.1: Existing younger apricot trees on the site may be transplanted to the new landscape areas on the site. The project would also plant new apricot trees throughout the site and a small apricot orchard next to the museum. The existing apricot trees located in the upper northeast corner of the site will be preserved.”

There are no other modifications to the Mitigation and Monitoring Program contained in Resolution No. 2010-12.


