# MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PUBLIC ARTS COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LOS ALTOS, HELD ON THURSDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2018, AT 5:00 P.M. AT LOS ALTOS CITY HALL, ONE NORTH SAN ANTONIO ROAD, LOS ALTOS, CALIFORNIA

#### **ROLL CALL**

<u>Action</u>: Upon a motion by Vice Chair Ellickson, seconded by Commissioner Wu, the Commission unanimously approved the minutes of the meeting of September 27, 2018, pending the revision of Item 5 Action to reflect that Vice Chair Ellickson and Commissioner Waldman met with the artist to discuss buying the piece and that the Commission will explore potential funding sources.

4. <u>Paint the Town Exhibit</u>: Discuss potentially loaning artwork temporarily from the History Museum *Paint the Town* exhibit Discuss potential art opportunities for the new Community Center

Commissioners reviewed each of the selected pieces and selected 10 to display in the Council Chambers. Commissioner King will craft language to notify the artists of whether their piece was selected.

3. <u>Loaned sculptures</u>: Discuss the status and disposition of sculptures loaned to the City

The Commission discussed the three sculptures whose loan periods are expiring.

5. <u>Council meeting recap</u>: Discuss the October 23, 2018 joint meeting with City Council and discuss next steps

The Commission discussed the joint meeting and identified next steps. Commission formed a subcommittee to develop an arts program for the Community Center including investigating other community center programs and meeting with the architects to discuss potential programming ideas (Waldman, Rini, King).

Commission also expressed interest in forming a subcommittee focused on developing percent for art funding (Ellickson).

**SUBJECT**: Election of Chair and Vice Chair

**RECOMMENDATION**: Nominate and elect members to serve as Chair and Vice Chair

#### **BACKGROUND**

Each October, the Commission nominates and elects a Chair and Vice Chair to serve for the coming year. This item was inadvertently left off the October agenda. This past year, Commissioners Rini and Ellickson served as Chair and Vice Chair respectively.

#### **DISCUSSION**

The election of Chair and Vice Chair is governed by the Commission and Committee Handbook. Any member of the Commission may serve as either Chair or Vice Chair. The current Chair will ask for nominations for the position of Chair. Any member may nominate another to serve. Nominations do not require a second. Once a member has been nominated for Chair, the Commission will vote. If a majority of members approve, that member will be deemed Chair. The process will then repeat for the election of Vice Chair.

Upon the conclusion of the election process for Chair and Vice Chair, the person elected Chair will take over as president of the meeting.

**RECOMMENDATION**: Discuss the disposition of the *Guardian* sculpture

#### **BACKGROUND**

The sculpture *Guardian* was installed at the corner of Fourth Street and State Street in 2013 as part of a Call for Art.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Guardian was loaned to the City by the artist Karen Cauvin Eustis for a five-year period. The loan is scheduled to expire this fall. The artist has reached out to determine the City's interest in acquiring the sculpture. In early September, members of the Public Arts Commission met with Ms. Eustis. On September 27, 2018, the Public Arts Commission (PAC) discussed the meeting with Ms. Eustis and Commissioners were generally tasked with exploring funding sources for acquisition of the sculpture.

It is recommended that the PAC discuss options for the sculpture.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The sculpture Archimedes Goose was installed at the corner of El Monte Avenue and Springer Road in 2016 as part of a Call for Art.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Archimedes Goose was loaned to the City by the artist Arnold Martin for a two-year period. The loan expired in October 2018. On October 25, 2018, the Public Arts Commission (PAC) determined not to extend the loan period and to request the artist remove the sculpture. Staff reached out to the artist regarding the removal of the sculpture at which time the artist offered to donate the sculpture to the City.

It is recommended that the PAC discuss the offer and determine whether to deny the donation or to recommend the Council accept the donation.
