1. Artwork from The Justice Vanguard Foundation: Consider the potential purchase of artwork from The Justice Vanguard Foundation and approve the 30-day, temporary loan of artwork to the City

Urna Bajracharya of the Justice Vanguard Foundation presented the artwork. Commissioners provided feedback and suggestions for next steps.

Direction: Commissioners directed that the next steps for the artwork are: 1) Chair Ellickson and Urna Bajracharya evaluate the artworks and their placement at Lincoln Park; 2) staff from the City's Recreation Department review the artworks to determine whether any artworks might be placed in City facilities; 3) Chair Ellickson introduce Urna Bajracharya to History Museum Executive Director Elisabeth Ward regarding the potential donation of artwork to the Museum; and 4) the artworks will remain at Lincoln Park until August 3, 2020.

2. Community Center Art: Receive an update from the subcommittee to discuss potential art for the new community center

Chair Ellickson provided an update on discussions regarding Conversation Peace.

3. Promotion of public art during COVID-19 Shelter-in-place order: Discuss the potential for promotion of public art during the COVID-19 Shelter-in-place order
