### **Senior Commission Recommendation to City Council**

At the Los Altos City Council meeting of October 13, 2015 the City Council took the following actions...

Action: Council affirmed that, should a bond measure pass, there will be space dedicated to senior use adjacent to uses that will be exclusive to seniors during hours to be defined, that the actual size of rooms and use will be further refined, and that the combination of dedicated and exclusive spaces will equal at least 10,000 gross square feet.

Action: Council unanimously directed the Parks and Recreation, Senior, and Youth Commissions to continue working on defining programmatic uses for the community center and relevant program adjacencies in and outside the community center.
