1. CHASE/Design Response Feedback

The Youth Commission recommended for the Underground to be submitted to Design Response to generate a design.

2. Letters to Santa

Dates discussed for responding to the letters from Santa are currently set for December 13 and 14 from 10 AM to 2 PM and Dec 15 to 17 from 3 PM to 5 PM.
