APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The commission agreed to assist in promoting the Dodgeball tournament as well as a Battle of the Bands that is being coordinated by volunteers on the Community Picnic Committee. It was suggested that tear-off flyers be used to help promote the events.

As a tradition, the Park, Arts and Recreation Commission would like to challenge the Youth Commission as part of the Bocce Ball Tournament at the Community Picnic. DEMARTINI MOVED that the Youth Commission play Bocce Ball at the community Picnic. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY BIEN AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY VOICE VOTE.

3. LAVA Donation – Staff announced that the Los Altos Village Association donated \$100 to teen programs and asked for a recommendation from the youth commission on how they would like to spend the funds.

ANGELO MOVED that the LAVA donation be used towards prizes for the Dodgeball Tournament winners. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COLEHOWER AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY VOICE VOTE
